



Surf Helmets and Surfboats

Your guide to new policy



In competition, it's the Boat Referee's call...

The policy states that following a risk assessment, the Boat Referee has the authority to determine if surf helmets must be worn. As a guide, for surf conditions of less than 1m, helmets are not required. The Boat Referee will conduct a risk assessment and consult with the Carnival Boat Panel of experienced sweeps and rowers. If they conclude that surf helmets are not required, then they do not have to be worn. Crews should always have their surf helmet available and must wear it if required as conditions may change.
