



Surf Helmets and Surfboats

Your guide to new policy



In training, it's the sweeps call...

The policy states that following a risk assessment prior to training, the sweep has the authority to determine whether helmets are worn. As a guide, for surf conditions of less than 1m, helmets are not required. In conditions greater than 1m, helmets are required unless a sweep conducts a risk assessment indicating that risks are acceptably low. Crews should always have their surf helmet available for every session and wear it if ordered by their sweep.
